

PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

The Ministry of Health notifies the public of an Ebola Outbreak in some West African Nations. There is a possibility that the number of countries affected will increase over time.

- Ebola is a deadly disease caused by a virus transmitted through contact with blood or other body fluids of an infected person or animal or by contact with contaminated objects.
- Avoid contact with blood or other body fluids of an infected person.
- Currently there is no licensed vaccine or cure.
- All Batswana coming from affected countries shall be subjected to the Ebola screening and passenger tracing form and quarantine when necessary.
- Travellers from West Africa shall be subjected to the Ebola screening and passengers tracing form.
- Travellers from Ebola affected countries shall be denied entry into Botswana to reduce the risk of introducing the disease.
