## EBOLA VIRUS GUIDELINES FOR IMMIGRATION AND AIRPORT AUTHORITIES

### What to do?

- People who are arriving from EBOLA Virus affected Countries (Guinea, Liberia and other countries at high risk, etc.) May be requested for clinical examination at port of entry.
- Immigration officers should alert health authorities of travellers with symptoms suggestive of Ebola.
- Suspected cases should be taken to the isolation room for assessment and management
